As folklore would have it, shilajit, traditionally referred to as "The Destroyer of Weakness", was found by the ancestors of the langur monkeys. The story goes that the vllagers of the Himalayan region observed these white monkeys prying at the cracks of the mountains to retrieve a black tar that was infused within the rock and gravel. During the summer months when the tar/rock was most accessible due to the heat, the monkeys would show up and gather it. Curiosity arose within the people making them ask, what made this substance so naturally attractive to these primates? What was the purpose? One thing led to the next and the observers began to harvest this organic attraction and unleashed its power.

The rest is history!



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Created from the slow decomposition of plant material over many centuries, deep in the rocks of high mountainous regions across the world.

In essence Shilajit is a natural concentrate of plants of the regions of the Himalayas, and is found in the Himalayan ranges in India, Nepal, Pakistan, China, and Tibet. The flora of the Himalayas is rich and varied, and for thousand of years the plants have come to life, absorbed nutrients from the soil, and then died out. This is a process which has been repeated again and again countless times, and continued for millennia.

It is believed that Shilajit found in the
Himalayas are the decomposed form of those plants, and the
particular biosphere of the Himalayas created them and
bestowed medicinal qualities to them.

EXUDES FROM THE ROCKS

As it develops, it becomes a sticky, mineral-infused substance. Eventually, stimulated by the intense heat of summer, it seeps out through the rocks.



In Sanskrit Means: "conqueror of mountains and destroyer of weakness".

In Sanskrit, it is also called Shilajatu, Shilaras, Adrija and Girija.

In Arabic arakul-dzhibol means 'sweat of mountains'.

Tibetan or Mongolian brag-shun or brag-zhun means

'juice of rock'.

Burmese kao-tui or chao-tui implies 'blood of the mountains'. Tamil language implies that it is the 'essence from the mountain'.

Second-most common name in Russian being mumie, mumiyo or mum- miyo means 'mountain balsam' or 'mountain tears'



Trace Minerals, Organic Acids & Organic Compounds.

One of the reasons that Shilajit is such a powerful healing substance is that it is packed with beneficial minerals,including silica, iron, calcium, copper, lithium, magnesium, manganese, phosphorous, sodium, and zinc.

Notonly is Shilajit rich in organic trace minerals (in this case, "organic" means plant-derived), but it also contains fulve acid, humic acid, amino acids, and plant-based antioxidants.



Holistic Metabolism Support

Shilajit provdes a number of minerals, organic acids and other organic compounds that play relevant roles in body metabolism.

Metabolism is a complex web of biochemical processes where the nutrients derived from ingested food are converted into forms that can be utilized by the body and eventually trigger most of the body's functions including those of the immune and nervous systems.

Bioavailability Enhancement

Not only does Shilajit contain its own wealth of nutrients, some of the nutrients it has, such as fulve acid improve the absorption and usage (bioavailability) of other consumed nutrients.

Rasayana

In the Ayurvedic discipline, Rasayana refers to both the teaching of rejuvenation and a category of substances and protocols for vgour, vtality, and strength. Shilajit is considered a Rasayana supplement, an adaptogen. It has been used for millennia asan ancient tool to rebalance the body's inner energies and enhance overall wellbeing.



The Elixir Of Life

Fulve Acid is termed a Super Cell Conductor – it has the vtal capability of realising the potential of all nutrients we consume. When minerals and trace elements from food come into contact with it, they are dissolved into a form that makes them more active and more available to the body. These minerals fuse with it and because of its molecular size, it has the ability to take these nutrients directly to all the cells of our bodies. Additionally, this compound makes the cells more permeable and receptive to these nutrients. Essentially, Fulve Acid mobilizes food to become our medicine.

Shilajit includes four of the six Ayurvedic tastes—pungent, bitter, salty, and astringent—and carries a pungent, heating energy, or vrya. While it is considered balancing for all three doshas of Vata, Pitta, and Kapha, its gentle heating nature can become aggravating for pitta if used in excess.

Traditionally, Shilajit is known as yoga vahi—which means "joining carrier"—because of its ability to carry and drive nutrients deep into the body so they can work most effectively. As a yoga vahi, shilajit can be taken with other herbs and supplements to enhance their effectiveness.

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Handpicked stones from highest reaches of Himalayas!

Golden brown rocks from, which are rich in Fulvc Acid & Minerals, from the highest reaches of Himalayas i.e.

16,000 – 18,000 ft. ab ve the sea level are handpicked during the month of summers.

These rocks are the purified and prepared according to traditional Ayurvedic methods to remove any impurities and ensure the Shilajit is safe for consumption. This method of purification involves a non-alcoholic extraction and filtration process using Triphala.
